## PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

- As the parent/guardian(s) of a player on Morris Elite Soccer Club, I agree to support Morris Elite and their teams and will insure that my child/player abide by the players code of conduct.
- Parent/guardians will refrain from any verbal abuse of players, coaches, referees, opponents and spectators during or after games.
- Parent/guardians will not interfere or distract any players at any time during games and practices.
- Parent/guardians will remain in designated spectator areas throughout the duration of all games and practices.
- Parent/guardians are to adhere to and respect all facility rules and regulations.
- Parent/guardians are expected to pick up and/or drop-off their child to practice and games at the time requested by the coach or manager and abide by all parking rules and regulations. A nominated adult is required to physically enter the practice field - especially after dark - to pick up their son or daughter. Players will not be allowed to leave the field and enter parking lot without a parent/guardian/adult.
- Parent/guardians are to refrain from any negative, abusive or derogatory comments about/towards Morris Elite players, opponents, referees or spectators during or after games; verbally, in writing or via the internet.
- Parent/guardians will not use or possess alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or weapons while attending Morris Elite games or training sessions.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO COACHING FROM SIDELINE IS PERMITTED BY PARENT/GUARDIANS** - this means any kind of direction such as “pressure”, “push up”, “drop-back” etc.
- Parent/guardians are not to voice issues concerning their child/player or coach in front of other parents/guardians/players. Players are encouraged to talk to the coach as opposed to the parent/guardians. Any players U11 or below can also be accompanied by a parent/guardian. We ask that you wait to discuss any issues or concerns with the team manager and/or coach directly until after a 24 hour period after the issue arises is required before doing so. If this is unsuccessful, parent/guardian should feel free to contact Management directly to resolve the matter.

- Players receiving yellow or red cards from any league or tournament are responsible for the fines issued or suspension. Parent/guardians are responsible for paying this fine.

At Morris Elite these codes are taken seriously to insure a safe, professional and nurturing environment to all our players. Parent/guardians are required to adhere to these codes in the best interest of their child. A Morris Elite director/coach will take the time to speak to parent/guardians regarding any arising issues. However, please note that you may or may not receive warning prior to any action being taken in response to failure to abide by the above code of conduct rules.

The Parent/guardians Code of Conduct has been written in the best interest of players, parent/guardians, coaches and to continuously improve the environment and services provided by Morris Elite.
